### **READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

### **EXECUTIVE REPORTS AND COMMUNICATION:**

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Discussion was held regarding the compressed schedule and how it would affect the Classified Staff at FC. All Senators were asked again to look at the needs list and report any updates/corrections that are needed from prior list.
