Campus Safety Discussion

- Kesha provided presentation that included senator feedback regarding AP – votes split 7 yes & 7 maybe
- Senator comment - utilizing campus safety and needing them to be protected. Referenced multiple recent events in news regarding school safety/threats.
- Senator comment - parking has been challenging and students from their program needing to walk further away from campus and needing protection and that campus safety should be able to protect themselves.
- Senator comment - Summer needed to call campus safety regarding unhoused individuals and another incident regarding an individual who was experiencing a mental health crisis and had a knife. Emphasized need for additional safety for our officers, and that they have training that prepared them in those incidents to deescalate.
- Senator comment - shared multiple incidents with Campus Safety that felt insensitive to vulnerable student populations. Emphasized need for sensitivity training to prevent these incidents in the future especially if they are going to be provided additional tools such as ASPs
- Senator comment - feeling uncomfortable with their own interactions with campus safety as a colleague and is unsure how students feel if they have similar, negative interactions.
- Motion made (Antionette) to extend senate meeting 10 minutes past 11:00 a.m. Scott seconded motion.
- Recording from BOT of campus safety officer EJ was played.
- Faculty guest asked if EJ was offered alternative tools because of being allergic to pepper spray. Shared that this question can be brought to Campus Safety director if he is able to attend future meeting.
- No further comments were made regarding the topic. Kesha shared that she will invite Selby again for the next Classified Senate meeting.
