On Research, Planning and Resolutions committee. An International student double majoring at Fullerton College. Antionette Motioned, Annika Seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

AS & ICC Final Report on Campus Safety – Julian Sanchez, Inter-Club Counsel Prof. Expert & Adjunct Faculty

Represented Associated Students as a staff member, alongside Ron Farol, who helped oversee the report RPR committee. Results collected from the student body was inconclusive as only about 100 students completed the survey. Staff helped RPR committee understand what a lit. review is, and how to gather sources from multiple sources and perspectives.

Pros: sense of safety with presence of weapons, but limited research on batons specifically. Correlated with guns. Another correlation was that although death penalty exists, crimes still happen.

Research on liability, training, certifications, and background on officers' previous history if employed with law enforcement. Students had questions about hiring process, trainings, insurance and financial questions.

Limitations (page 32 on report) - training for students on RPR on how to conduct research. Staff who supported limitations with time. Adjunct having to pull resources from other campuses they teach at for research databases. Recommendations (page 24) - if implemented, there are limited staff that can support to help make these goals successful.

Report has been shared with PAC who is voting on the AP tomorrow (11/13).

Kesha shared with Faculty Senate that we are asking for transparency in Campus Safety processes.

- **Faculty Senate (Antionette Triefenbach)** - Two questions regarding AP 7600 edits and the addition of the baton. Voted not to add, next meeting will discuss edits. Approved faculty hiring rankings. Faculty

representative shared that many of us have heard the SCFF presentation. Passed resolution about that the FON (Faculty Obligation Number) shouldn't be the ceiling and more full-time faculty need to be hired. Common Course numbering (starting with 9), course numbers need to match across the state. Registration will begin April 2025 for Summer/Fall 2025 courses

- **Student Senate (Samiy Castillo Bolivar)** - Reflected on AS presidents statement on RPR committees research on AP7600 and potential addition of batons. Worked alongside Daniel Berumen about the data they collected, and it was agreed upon that data was inconclusive. Shared appreciation to campus safety officers and appreciate the time to review. They were unsure of the potential cost of adding ASPs (purchase, training, upkeep). Addressed potential legal implications. Reviewed the Clery report which showed low to no reports of crime on campus, which raises the question about the need. Highlighted research on Weapons Priming Theory and militarizing the campus (and throughout NOCCCD) in final report on AP7600. Requested more transparency, updated website to help build greater connection with the campus and community. Other defensive measures such as cameras and vests. Next RPR meeting will be in Spring 2025 to look into making a resolution regarding these recommendations. AS abstained from voting on edits to AP7600.
- **PAC (Kesha Shadwick)** - PBSC & PRPC updated the mission and vision (on their website). Guided Pathways team demonstrated the Program Mapper. Barbershop Talk will be tomorrow (11/13) for students.
- **CSEA (any attendee from last meeting)** - BOT Ed. Lopez, Mark Lopez, Ryan Bent have been re/elected. CSEA meeting on 11/19 at 11:30 a.m.. Second round of nominations will be made for CSEA E-Board.
