10:45 a.m. – Accreditation Steering Committee (ASC) – Kim Vandervort

- 2 open seats for classified professionals and 2 AS reps on ASC
- Accreditation allows us to qualify for federal grants & contracts, disburse FA, and credits to be transferred
- Standards are based on the goal of continuous quality improvement
- Reaffirmed for accreditation. Standards changed during as we were in the accreditation process, impacts how we track our efforts going forward.
 - Includes using mission and core values are driving factors not just performative, emphasis real results not just documentation, fewer standards that are more specific with stronger focus on equitable outcomes, social justice policies, and institutional accountability, greater focus on institution's outcomes not just course outcomes
 - ASC committee will continue meeting with various constituency groups to discuss standards and changes being implemented, starting review and adjustments early so we can be proactive rather than reactive,
 - Senator asked if there are specific guidelines of what they review when they do site visits, Kim confirmed its based on areas they want to further examine and provide this information beforehand

 - Job descriptions are done but not being released, tactic to prolong process as they're unsure if they can afford salary changes/increases of both job studies, being asked to roll over IT job study into the McKnight study to start over process all over again.
 - CSEA shared attending BOT meetings show we notice and care.
 - Contract has gone through several articles already, but salary is not being touched until other items are finalized
 - Senator asked if folks are open to inviting Chancellor to come to campus to learn what we're doing, Senator shared we can ask Olivo to request chancellor's visit

Treasurer's Report- Scott, start with 20,000 every year, 500 spent on polos 350 spent on hospitality 15,000 reserved for travel, remaining is used for Spring Luau and Recognition award gifts,

Gathering of the Senates (Andrea & Annika)- IVC, southern regions senates coming together, topics included AI usage, virtual senate meetings allowed through Brown Act, and potentially big news coming in Summer

Exploring Virtual Senate Meetings - AB 2449 ends on December 31, 2025 - No limit for public but limited for senators to be able to vote on items (no more than 20% of meetings attended virtually, need to have camera on), since we receive public funds from campus we need to adhere to Brown Act, Senator shared more colleagues expressed they would be able to come if virtual attendance option was available, **Antionette motioned to establish a zoom link for guests to attend meetings starting next meeting March 20th, Matt seconded.
