PRESENTATIONS *(not to exceed 15 minutes each)*

SEAC (1st Read of Equity Plan) – Ericka Adakai and Anita Juarez

This is a report and reflect on the past 3 years and create a plan for the next 3 years

- Focus on our disproportionately impacted students, aligning with Vision 2030 (successful enrollment, Transfer level English and Math, and persistence).
- Senator question – is this report to help gain more funding through SEA? Anita shared that SEA funding is already allocated but this process will help gain better clarity on how that funding will be allocated. Senator shared concerned about increasing counseling capacity with less funding.
- Dr. Ziza Delgado will be co-chairing SEAC as interim Dean of Ethnic Studies
- Senator asked question about ANAPISI Grant being cut and needing to be used within the next year. Anita shared they are reaching out to other campuses on how to navigate these sudden changes and how to navigate it collectively.

Classified Senate: meeting dates, agendas, and minutes:

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- Senator asked question about HSI Transformation Team having 5 key strategies – how to create plan that is not presentative or workshop based. Anita shared that SEAC is going to be focusing on a few goals that are related to the Disproportionally impacted students rather than including everything.
- Senator asked about Student Advocate program being a high-ticket program and how classified roles will be considered or federal work-study
- Senator asked about compensation for bi-lingual and multi-lingual staff faculty

COMMITTEE AND REP UPDATES *(not to exceed 1 minute each)*

- **Faculty Senate (any attendee from last meeting)** - Exec Team is 3/5 filled. Mission statement was not approved and workgroup will be established to come up with next steps.
- **Student Senate (any attendee from last meeting)** - All Student Senator seats have been filled. Parking discussion regarding safety of structure and lack of parking spots for large vehicles. Lack of therapy support was discussed. Inequitable offerings of STEM courses and varying levels of difficulty. Possible merge of ICC and AS and discussion about advisors.
- **PAC (A.Shellenbarger)** - enrollment has surpassed 20k! College will be promoting enrollment through short-term courses and Winter intersession (especially with local 4-year students). Overview of Student Conduct process, with the Dean of Student Support services projected to start December 15. Invitation to grand opening of Student Support Center building tomorrow from 9-12p.m..
- **CSEA (any attendee from last meeting)** - Our approved CBA will be published once formatting is finalized. CSEA was not involved in the development or implementation of the Classified FIT Program. Conversation about Hourly/PEs doing Classified Work and to share any instances where a Classified Professional should be hired with CSEA. Reach out to CSEA for support if there is conflict with your IMS. Conversation about holidays and alternative schedules.

Roles of the Participants in Participatory Governance

Classified Senate

The Classified Senate represents the classified staff in participative decision making and in the participatory governance process which develops and formulates policy and practice with no collective bargaining related effect, but not limited to, activities which include: (1) representing the perspective of classified staff in policy and procedure deliberations; (2) offering staff in- service activities; (3) communicating among the various interest groups and classified staff of Fullerton College; (4) collaborating with CSEA for appointment of classified staff on all governance committees; (5) maintaining the delineation of responsibility between the Classified Senate and CSEA. The Classified Senate has no responsibility in any area related to bargaining or working conditions as such issues are the explicit responsibility of CSEA. CSEA has the right to appoint the classified representatives to all participatory governance committees. The College President ensures that the recommendations and opinions of classified staff are given every reasonable consideration within this structure.

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
