Call to Order: 10:04 a.m.

Approval of the Minutes from December 3, 2025 – make corrections and approve at next meeting.

Public Comment (1 minute per person, not to exceed 5 minutes)

- Jordan Fallon: Call for ten scoring committee members for Students of Distinction. Applications close March 11 and scoring ends before spring break. Elizabeth provided clarification on committee scoring and writing letters of recommendations.

APPOINTMENTS

None scheduled – Convocation Division meetings that towards the end of the semester there will be elections for president, treasurer, secretary and senators for anyone interested in nominations. Opening up in May.

COMMITTEE AND REP UPDATES *(not to exceed 1 minute each)*

- **Faculty Senate (any attendee from last meeting) -**
 - Discussed APB40 service animal vote and rapid response recommendation for president/professional learning office. Looking at proposed joint collaborative consultation of senate and unions. Looking for feedback to vote at a future meeting.
- **Student Senate (any attendee from last meeting) -**
 - Elizabeth - Future student senate meetings have moved from Thursday to Tuesday. Held their first student senate meeting on Tuesday with great turnout with executive leaders present. AS is planning to produce an informational video about what to do if ICE is on campus. AS, SLL, and Promise will co-host a club rush event called Sugar Rush and will send interest form for clubs and orgs to participate. Kindness Campaign will also be present.
- **PAC (A.Shellenbarger) -**
 - Update from Dec: Language change from academic and progress probation to academic and progress notice. Pres Olivo shared that financial aid must follow federal rules by keeping probation vs notice to refer to students whose GPA falls below those requirements. They discussed new CRM Element451 (shoutout to Yamileth). She shared the concept of realistic optimism on the topic of budgets. Campus collaborations committee reports to PAC and Faculty Senate and are proposing

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to meet week 5 of fall and week 12 of spring semester, twice a year. The deadline for submitting culturally relevant art proposals is Feb. 25.

- **CSEA (any attendee from last meeting) -**
 - Articles 4 and 18 have opened for negotiations. They are looking for people to support two CSEA committees: events and hospitality, and nominations.

AGENDA TOPICS

- **Vote Needed: Utilization of the Classified Lounge as a Voting Center from May 27-June 3 and October 28-November 4**
 - Annika clarified with Miranda to refrain from installing permanent stickers on the floor or windows due to prior misuse.
 - Bryce motions in favor. Victor seconds. Heather suggested exploring options to maintain cleanliness standards in its original state or better. Chuck expressed concern about classified staff being able to use space during this period. Annika can ask if a certain section can be made available with a divider in place.
 - 11 yeses, 2 nos, 1 abstention. Vote passes, with the condition that the room be returned to its original state.
 - Concern was shared about staff feeling uncomfortable with being monitored for cleanliness in classified lounge and conflict with cleaning responsibility.
- **Faculty Senate recommendation for rapid response**
 - Bridget shared that this was a recommendation for President Olivo. Faculty staff know what to do in the case that ICE were to be on campus. Annika shared with the executive team about concerns with training for staff vs training from district. Faculty Senate shared the importance of the AP 3415 with President Olivo.
- **Kindness Campaign Nomination Form**
 - Bryce shared the nomination form draft for feedback and discussed dissemination strategies. Suggestions were to revise the form to include AS branding and renaming “Kindness Campaign” to “Fullerton College Kindness Campaign”. Beppa will share the form with her committee and David/AS to make a promotional video. Elizabeth will share at Student Senate. Agendize for faculty senate meeting.
